The projects identified in the Bond include additions to and renovations of existing facilities to address aging facilities, infrastructure and to provide equity across the district.

BOND PROPOSAL: \$35,000,000

The District's anticipated plans for the Bond funds are described below.

Crystal City High School Additions & Renovations 78%

Construct new CLASSROOMS, ART ROOM, CULINARY KITCHEN, ADMINISTRATION AREAS, LIBRARY, CAFETERIA/KITCHEN and SUPPORT SPACES. Major and minor renovations to the existing gymnasium
Construct new AUDITORIUM and support spaces.
Construct new GYMNASIUM and support spaces.
Construct new SCIENCE ROOMS. Minor renovations to existing science building.

Fly Junior High School Additions & Renovations 20%

Construction of new ADMINISTRATION AREAS, new LIBRARY, new CAFETERIA/KITCHEN. Minor renovations to existing administration areas. Demolish existing "L Building."

Benito Juarez Middle School Additions & Renovations 1%

Construction of new MUSIC BUILDING
New SCIENCE LAB

Dr. T. Rivera/Zavala Elementary School Additions & Renovations 1%

Construction of new ELEMENTARY GYM

Tax Information: If approved, the estimated tax impact of this Bond is 33 cents for a total tax rate of \$1.49. This represents an increase of approximately \$8.32 per month per \$50,000 of taxable property value. **Housing Authority Residents** are exempt from paying this tax.

Voters Over 65: Under state law, the dollar amount of school taxes imposed on the residence homestead of a person 65 years of age or older may not be increased above the amount paid in the first year after the person turned 65, regardless of changes in tax rate or property value, except for later improvements.

Housing Authority and Section 8 Residents are exempt from paying school property taxes.
